Ryan was an exceptional darts player and his parents have organised the event with us since Ryan passed. The first year 2017 we raised funds for the Teenage and Young Adult Cancer Fund at the Churchill and since then the family have chosen local charities to support.

This year's event will take place on the 22<sup>nd</sup> August and the family have kindly decided that half of the monies raised will go to OOSO and the other half to TYAF.

We have consistently raised over £3,000 every year and it would be great to publicise the event to OOSO members and supporters and get them along as well this year.

The event has a raffle which is always well supported by local businesses but any additional prize donations would be more than welcome.

A BBQ, which is paid for by the club, and all monies raised go into the pot with various other fund-raising activities.

Ryan's father Martin Bulls, who is a county player, has used his contacts to have professional dart players attend as well.

Full details have yet to be decided for this year's event but the date is always a priority so that it fits with the local darting calendar because so many players were friends of Ryan and want to attend to honour his memory.

Witney has plenty of accommodation and food options if you want to make a day of it and not have to worry about driving afterward.
